All clients with medication needs must have the electronic medication administration record (eMAR) completed every shift. DSPs may **not** administer any medications (prescription or OTC) if they are not in AxisCare.

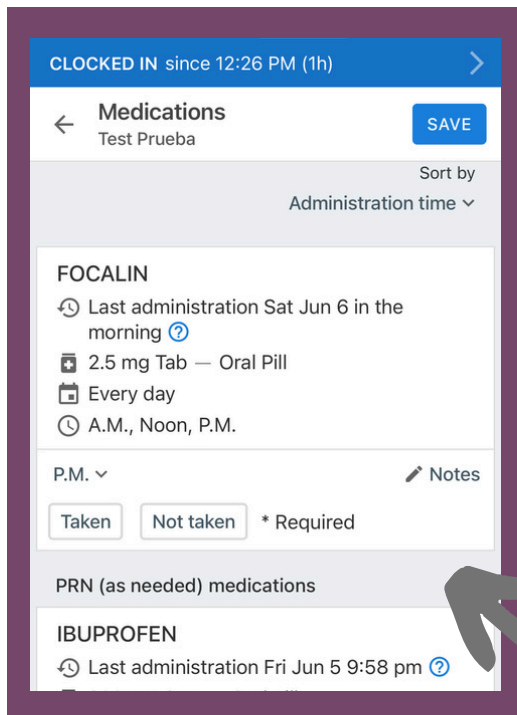
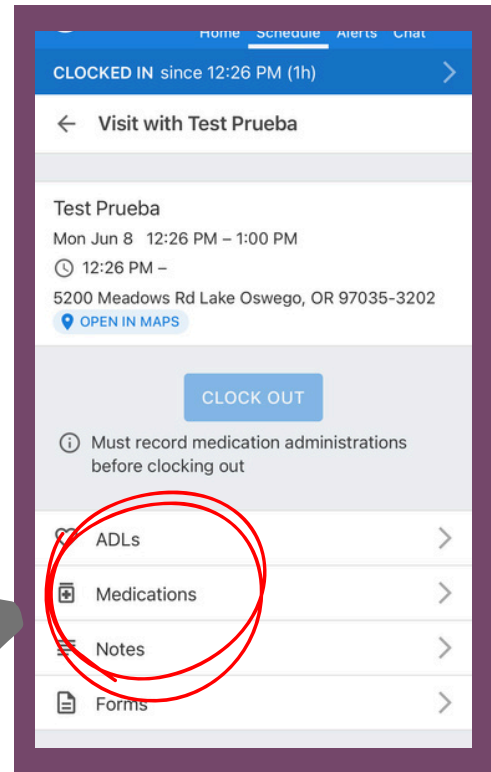

While in your current shift, click on Medications. You can view and update this tab throughout your shift. Be sure to click “Save” in the top right every time you make a change.

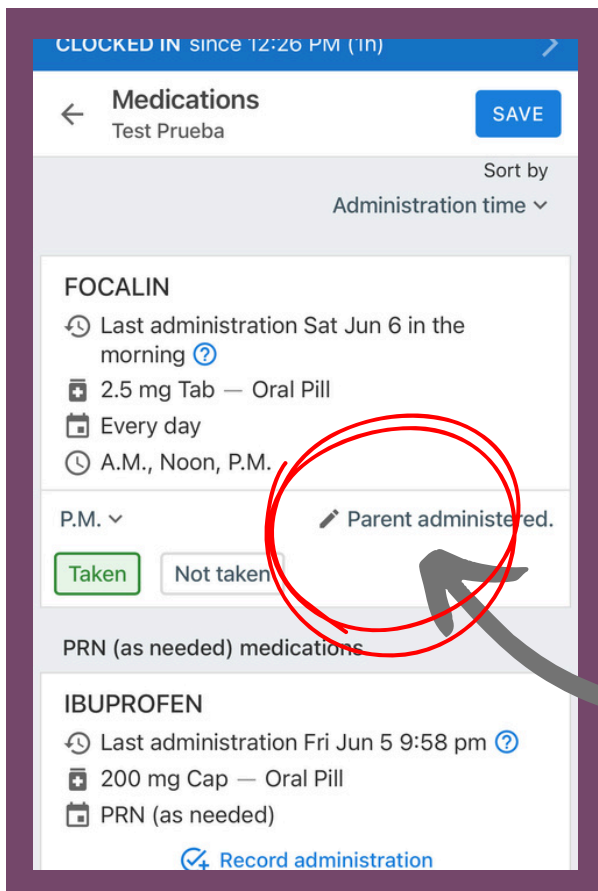
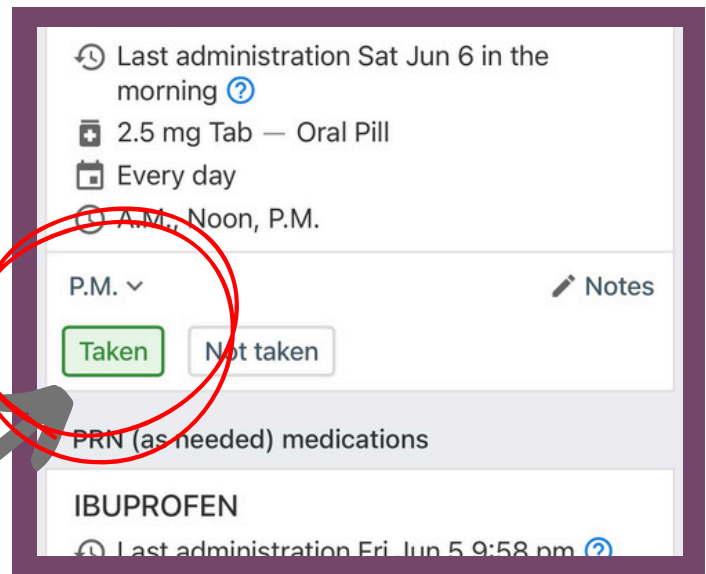
Here you'll see a list of all medications due during that current shift, as well as any PRN (as-needed) medications.

4 Mark Taken or Not Taken on all regularly scheduled medications.



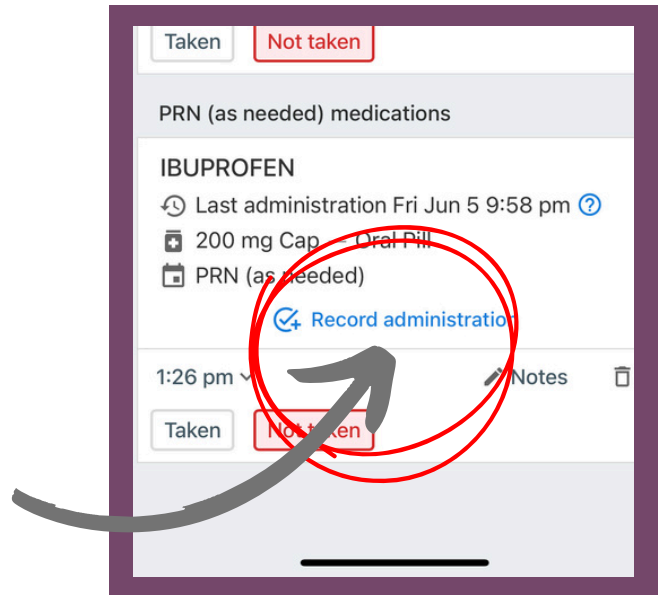
5 You can also use the note feature to add details.
Ex. Not Taken? *Add a note why it was not taken.*
Ex. Taken, but not administered by you? *Add a note to record who administered it.*

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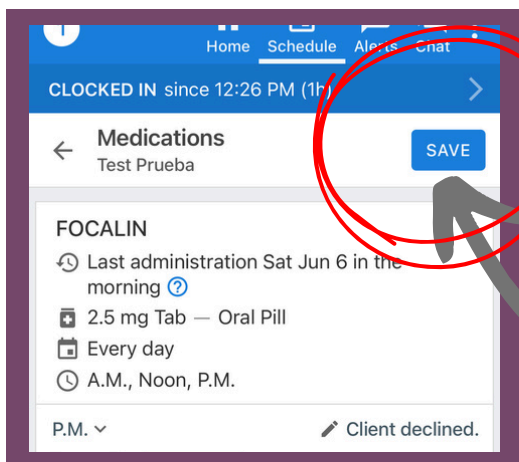

6 Lastly, click Record Administration for any PRNs. If you did not administer it, change it to Not Taken, and you do not need to leave a note. If you did administer, add a note explaining why it was needed.



Tip: Click on the administration time to change it if you actually administered it earlier in your shift.

Save in the top right and you can clock out at the end of your shift. You can always come back and record more medications while you are still clocked in.
